_gid	First-party cookie	Google Analytics - To distinguish unique users and sessions on website	24 h
crumb	First-party cookie	Session cookie to prevent cross-site request forgery (CSRF)	Session
ss_cookieAllowed	First-party cookie	SquareSpace - Remembers if visitor agreed to placing analytics cookies on web browser	30 days
ss_cvr	First-party cookie	SquareSpace - Identifies unique visitors and tracks a visitors sessions on a site	400 days
ss_cvt	First-party cookie	SquareSpace - Identifies unique visitors and tracks a visitors sessions on a site	30 minutes
